Please use either the King James Version or the American Standard Version in class and papers. None other are allowed unless one is referencing them for his paper or comparing them for purposes of class debate.

Outside assignments for those auditing: there are none. But, for those taking the course for a certificate who have not graduated from a two-year preaching school there is required a paper on a self-chosen General Biblical Introduction subject. The foregoing paper will be from eight to ten pages in length and reading cards will be turned in containing author, title of book, and notes taken while researching. **[For the most part, MLA style is used here except for block quotes which are single spaced here. See the MSOP writing instructions sheet given as a hand-out.]**

For those who are taking this course for the graduate diploma, your paper must be on a different subject from the one done while in school and be 18 to 25 pages in length with research shown on reading cards handed in also.

There will also be a take-home exam given at the next to last week of this semester that will be due the following Thursday, December 14.
